A First, there are many boarding kennels in the Sydney area. To name a couple, Hanrob has two locations – one at the airport and the main one in Sydney's south. Another is the Woodcroft Guesthouse for Cats and Dogs, which is up on the northern beaches.

If you don't want to put Jaffa in a kennel, you can always leave him in a family home. Companies like Don't Fret Pet! match up your dog to one of the families on their files, and Jaffa goes to live with them while you're away. You get to meet the family before you go to make sure everyone is happy.

The other option is to keep Jaffa at home and have a house/pet sitter come into your home.
